### **New ESL office coming along**

Construction of the downtown headquarters of **ESL Federal Credit Union** is moving along, CEO David Fiedler told the Rochester Rotary Club.

Fiedler said work on the six-story building is slightly ahead of schedule but will slow down to wait for steel to be delivered in January.

A parking garage connected to the building will open in fall 2009 and employees will move from Irondequoit in spring 2010.

Fiedler said part of the credit union's motivation for building a headquarters when its current lease expires was its recent growth. Since the former Eastman Savings and Loan broke away from Eastman Kodak Co. and became a credit union in the mid-1990s, membership has nearly tripled, to 290,000, and assets have grown to \$3.4 billion from \$1.2 billion.
