

Introduction



2025 Homeowner Report

ESL Federal Credit Union developed a new homeowner survey report in response to significant changes within the housing market in the last several years. The survey includes nearly two dozen questions about the local housing market and responses from approximately 300 people from 31 towns in the counties of Monroe, Ontario, Livingston, and Seneca.

Key Findings

- ❖ More than half of the homebuyers surveyed haven't considered moving since 2023.
- ❖ 63% of respondents are not considering a move at all.
- For 41% of respondents who have considered moving, the main reason is downsizing.
- ❖ Pittsford, Webster, and Penfield are the top three location preferences for homeowners who would like to move within Greater Rochester.
- ❖ 55% of respondents consider it important to choose a location to live near family and friends.

Summary

A common theme among survey respondents is that it's too expensive for them to move due to high prices and low inventory. Despite challenges in the housing market, respondents still report that Greater Rochester is a good place to live.

- Survey area: Greater Rochester Region
- Distribution to approximately 2,500 Swagbucks app users
- Survey window: April 28 May 19
- Received 290 responses


