List/describe sports teams, clubs, or organizations, etc. during the last two years.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

List and describe all community involvement from the last two years. List the organization you worked with, the dates of volunteer service, and your responsibilities.

WORK EXPERIENCE

List any work experience during the last two years.

- **ESSAY**

- Provide an example or story of how you help or have helped your community thrive and prosper.
- Your community could mean your neighborhood, your family, your school, your place of worship, your group of friends etc.
- One page only, double spaced, typed, 11-pt. font.

- **LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION**

- One letter from a school official, coach or community/volunteer organization where you volunteered.
- Clearly illustrates their support for the student to receive this scholarship.
- No more than one page.
